



Doors to the Multi-Purpose Hall are found to the left and right sides of the front desk.




Glass doors to the Social Hall and the Bible Study Rooms are found to the left side of the front desk, past the escalator.

Head out of the front doors and walk towards the LAI Building. Doors are located just beside the lawn. Escalators and elevators are available to get to the second and third floors.




### from the second floor lobby

## CONFRONTING THE CRISIS IN CHURCH

## CULTIVATING A CULTURE OF ADMONITION

The sermon "Cultivating a Culture of Admonition" explores how a Christ-centered community grows through loving correction, based on Colossians 1:28. Admonition, meaning to warn, counsel, or correct, is essential for discipleship, safeguarding leadership and accountability within the church. It is not about harsh criticism or personal preferences but aligning lives with God's Word. By committing to God's Word, fostering wisdom-based discipleship, and creating a safe environment for truth-telling, the church can cultivate a culture where people are lovingly corrected and restored to maturity in Christ.

## TRUE LOVE NEVER FAILS

In 2024, 52 out of every 100 googled questions were "how" ones - with "How many days until Christmas?," coming in at number 5. A further 25 out of every 100 were "What" questions - such as "What time is it?" The rest consisted of When, Where and Who questions. One category of questions however was completely missing from the analysis - "Why" questions. Why am I here? Why do I feel empty? Why do these kinds of things happen to me? Many times we ask these questions with God in the equation. If there is a loving God, why doesn't He do this? Or stop that? Or allow this?


